In July of 2006, I watched the U.S. Touring Car Championship (USTCC) race held in Miller Motorsports Park, UT, on Speed and instantly knew what my long-term goal with my car would be – to go wheel-to-wheel racing. The overarching goal for 2007 is to earn my wheel-to-wheel competition license through NASA, and have my car prepared for the German Touring Sportscar Challenge for the 2008 season. Specifically, however, the goals for this year are:

- Earn my competition license
- Prepare the car for wheel-to-wheel racing, which includes:
  - Removing the interior, heating core, and air conditioning
  - Installing a cage to meet NASA Club Code & Regulations (CCR)
  - Installing a fire suppression system
  - Ensure all equipment is FIA certified
- Continue to attend HPDEs to gain experience
- Attend racing schools as necessary to earn my license
- Garner more sponsorships to help offset the cost of travel, additional equipment and tires, and entry fees
